



SOUTH FORK WIND FARM

Jackson County, MN

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The South Fork Wind Farm is a 20 megawatt wind farm under development in Jackson County, Minnesota. The project is a development of Geronimo Wind Energy, LLC, a utility-scale developer based out of Edina, Minnesota. The South Fork Wind Farm is located in Jackson County in southwestern Minnesota and represents a total investment of nearly \$32 million dollars once fully developed. Jackson County's excellent wind resource and existing power transmission availability makes the area ideal for wind development. Geronimo plans to construct up to 13 turbines to produce the 20 megawatts needed, and will work with local, nationally respected construction partners to bring the project to completion.

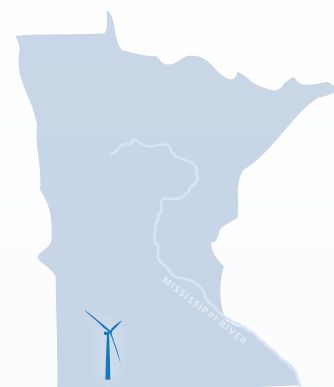
